



AMADEUSZ KAZUBOWSKI-HOUSTON

Born in 1996, thirteen year old Amadeusz Kazubowski-Houston began his music studies at age 5. He is presently a scholarship student at the distinguished Young Artists Performance Academy at The Royal Conservatory. Amadeusz is a student of Li Wang and James Anagnoson and has studied with Marina Geringas.

Amadeusz has won numerous awards at various festivals across Canada. This past September, Amadeusz performed in a solo recital in Elblag, Poland. In July, Amadeusz was featured at the Music Niagara Festival in their “Showcase of Young Virtuosos” solo recital. Earlier in 2009, Amadeusz was invited to perform at YAPA’s Showcase Concert, and the Glenn Gould School of Music’s fundraiser gala, Mozart Unlaced. In 2008, Amadeusz performed at the 4th National Music Pedagogy Conference Gala Concert in Poland. Recent performances also include the Vladimir Spivakov Foundation’s Young Stars of the Young Century Concert (Toronto Centre for the Arts), and the Chopin and Friends Concert (Living Arts Centre, Mississauga) on an invitation from internationally renowned Polish pianist Piotr Paleczny.

Amadeusz also plays the pipe organ and volunteers for several charitable organizations on an ongoing basis.
